## Dear Landowner:

The Phillips Conservation District is accepting orders for trees and shrubs for the 2025 spring planting season.

In an effort to provide our customers with the most complete and up-to-date information available; the Phillips Conservation District (PCD) is providing interested individuals with website ordering information for the three Nurseries that have supplied our trees and shrubs in the past as well as a new nursery that we'd like to try – Schumacher's in Minnesota.

Because the Nurseries have a minimum order requirement, it is advisable for individuals to continue to place their orders through the Conservation District. To place an order, please complete the attached tree order form and return it to the PCD/NRCS office along with your payment as soon as possible. A 30% shipping and handling fee is added to each order.

You may order directly from the State Nursery using their online order form, or you may place your order with the Conservation District.

Orders will be accepted until April 1, 2025, but you are encouraged to place your order as soon as possible to have the best chance of getting what you want. You can expect the orders to be shipped between the mid-April and mid-May 2025.
